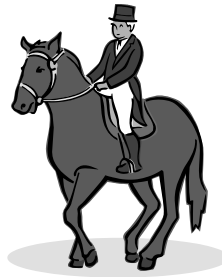

DIRECTIONS FROM MARRIOTT TO KENTUCKY HORSE PARK (approximately 15 minutes)

From Motel Entrance, turn right on Newton Pike (922). Follow Newton Pike to 4-Way- Stop intersection. (Newton Pike and Iron Works Parkway) Turn Left on Iron Works Parkway. Campground Entrance will be on your right. **For Obedience and Rally take the first road right after Campground Entrance and follow across top of the hill.** About three-quarters down the paved road, turn onto grass to Obedience/Rally tent on the left.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. The Cluster Show Site will be available at 6:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 2, 2010. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Monday.
2. All parking is governed by the Bluegrass Cluster Show. Handicap parking for cars and vans only (not RV's) will be available & marked. A valid handicap state sticker must be displayed on the vehicle.
3. Responsibility for an exhibitor's child is the exhibitor's – both for the child's welfare and any damages done by the child.
4. The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
5. No electricity available on event grounds.
6. No bicycles or private golf carts allowed on event grounds.
7. No dog washing facilities provided.
8. No smoking under any of the tents.
9. This Show is governed by the American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read and be familiar with the AKC Agreement on the back side of the Official AKC Entry Form.
10. No entries can be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted after the entries have closed.
11. An administrative fee of \$2.00 per entry fee will be charged for cancellation of an entry prior to closing of entries, and such refund check will be mailed after the date of this show.
12. Entries not on Official AKC Forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable. Entry Form must show the name of the Club and date of the show.
13. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
14. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Practicing in rings prohibited.
15. Dogs need be present only for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be removed from the show grounds.
16. The event giving club, the Trial Secretary, their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
17. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing, email, or fax prior to close of entries
18. Agents may indicate their name on the entry form for inclusion in the catalog, provided they are at least 18 years of age and neither own nor co-own the dog.
19. RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee of \$30.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in his being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
20. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Trial/Show Committee, or for a bitch that comes into season after the closing date of the show.
21. Dogs are to be leashed or confined while in the Kentucky Horse Park premises unless competing in the off-leash portion of the obedience/rally trials or in a designated dog park.
22. All dog solid waste must be promptly picked up and properly disposed.
23. IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT: A Show Committee hearing may be held for individuals reported for any motel complaints (including failure to scoop poop). It is up to the exhibitors to respect motel property. Do not let your dogs destroy or foul the rooms. Put plastic under crates. Use only designated exercise areas. Please respect others.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows" and the "Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline" and, if this entry is for an obedience trial, the "Obedience Regulations", have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge, judging at this show, under AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or leaser of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss of injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in.; over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
